Out of a list of 40 top inventions, here are my top 5:

The Car Heater: If you grew up where I did you would thank Margaret A. Wilcox every single day you got in your car. She invented the car heater in 1893.

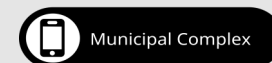
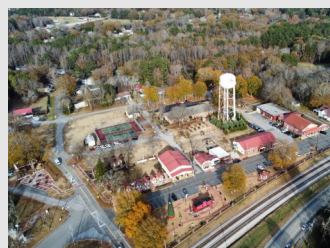
The Computer Algorithm: Without the work of Ada Lovelace the world could be quite far behind technologically from where it is.

Kevlar: A lifesaving and groundbreaking invention which went on to be used by Police worldwide was invented by chemist Stephanie Kwolek.

Stem Cell Isolation: Ann Tsukamoto co-patented the process of isolating stem cells from bone marrow. Who knew this would be a big part of cancer research and would help save the lives of hundreds and thousands of people?

Monopoly: Many of us remember the days sitting on the porch playing a marathon game of Monopoly. Elizabeth Magie originally designed it in 1904, then called "The Landlord's Game". Parker Brothers later paid Ms. Magie \$500 for the rights to the original game.

These are just the tip of the iceberg (also, Maria Beasley invented the life rafts used on the Titanic and helped save over 700 lives) of inventions and contributions by women throughout history. Take some time this month to research yourself and see what other contributions were made by women.

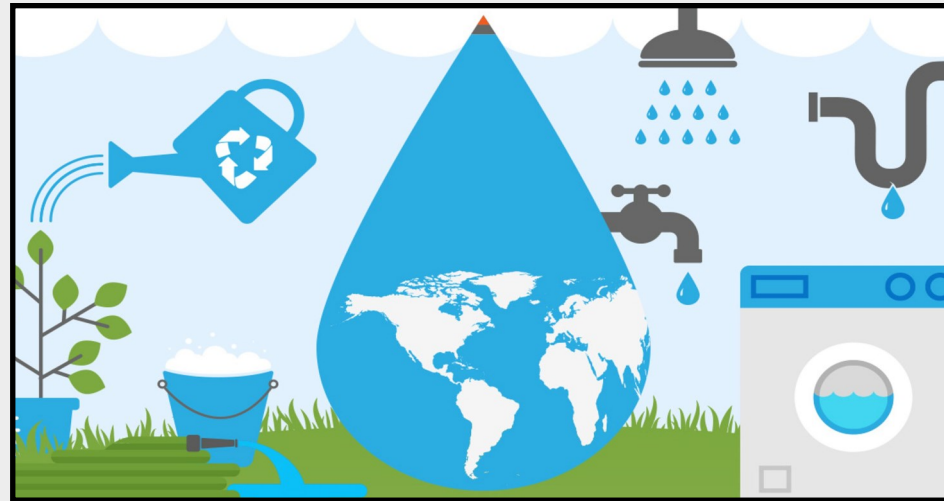


# PUBLIC WORKS

The hydrosphere is the total amount of water present on the earth. We have a finite supply of water on Earth. We all need to do OUR part by conserving water when possible.

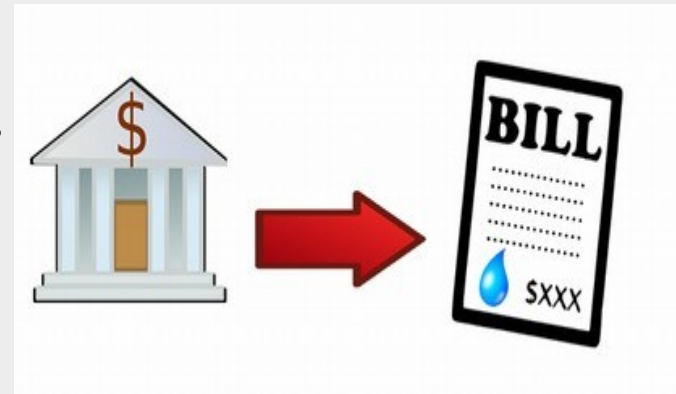
- 1 - Close the tap while not in use.
