UTILITY BILLING FAQ

Ensuring transparency, here are the key steps and dates for our utility billing cycle:

1. Bill Distribution: Bills are generated on the 1st and usually arrive within 7 days.

2. Payment Due Date: Payments are due by the 15th, with a 10% penalty for late payments.

3. Disconnection Policy: Failure to pay or arrange payment by the 25th leads to disconnection the next day.

Failure to maintain payment arrangements makes individuals ineligible for future arrangements.

4. Bill Inquiry: Contact us at 770-963-4002 if you haven't received your bill by the 15th.

<u>5. Payment Options</u>: We offer various convenient payment methods:

- Use the payment drop box at City Hall

- Make over-the-phone payments
- Set up automatic drafts
- Utilize our secure online payment portal
