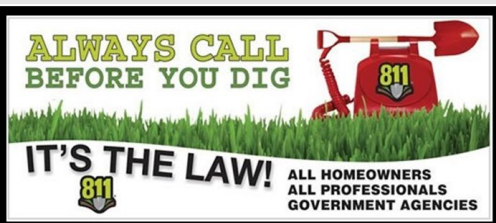

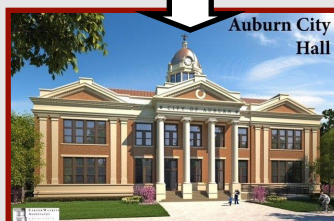


**New Municipal Complex Update**

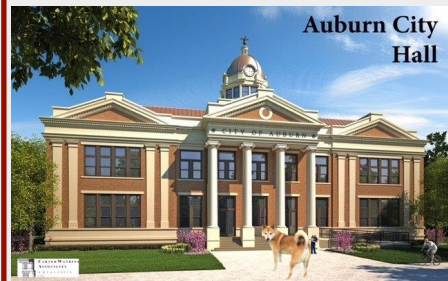
