Police Officer Position

The starting pay and benefits package is competitive, and will commensurate with qualifications and experience. Auburn Police Officers work a preferred 12-hour shift which results in every-other weekend off. Additionally, all APD Officers are provided a take-home vehicle upon completion of the FTO program. All uniforms and primary equipment is provided by the City of Auburn. Salary range: \$32K - \$40K

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years of age and U.S. Citizen who is physically and mentally able to perform the essential job functions of the position and be the holder of a valid Georgia Driver's License with a good driving record.
- Must possess a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent, A college degree is preferred but not a requirement for this position.
- No prior convictions by any State or by the Federal Government of any crime the punishment for which could have been imprisonment in the Federal or State Prison institution; nor have been convicted of sufficient misdemeanors.
- All applicants must be public service oriented, of good moral character and willing to be assigned shift work; this includes but is not limited to occasional Holiday schedules, day and night shift schedules and periodic mandatory overtime.

Successful candidates will undergo a personal interview, extensive background investigation that includes psychological, polygraph, drug and alcohol screening.
