Republic Services Trash Prices EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2025

Dear Residents of Auburn,

This newsletter provides an important update regarding the cost of your residential trash collection services provided by Republic Services. We understand that cost changes can impact your household budget, and we want to ensure you are well-informed about these adjustments.

Republic Services has recently announced an increase in their rates for trash pickup, which will affect all residential customers in Auburn. These changes are scheduled to take effect soon.

Here is a breakdown of the rate adjustments:

- **Standard Monthly Service (one can):** The monthly rate will increase from \$25.50 to \$30.75 per address.
- **Additional Can:** The monthly fee for an additional trash can will increase from \$13.91 to \$14.64.
- **Annual Yard Waste Service:** For residents who directly subscribe to Republic Services for annual yard waste collection, the annual fee will increase from \$164.35 to \$172.95.

We understand that any price increase can be a concern. The City of Auburn works diligently to ensure our residents receive essential services at a reasonable cost. While the City manages the contract with Republic Services, the pricing decisions are ultimately made by the service provider.

We hope to see you at these fantastic community events throughout April and early May! Let's make this a month to remember in Auburn!




STAR STUDENT


