

JOHNATHEN'S ADVICE ON YARD DEBRIS

Yard debris, including leaves and other organic plant material like shrubbery trimmings and grass clippings, are a significant source of stormwater pollution. Did you know that storm drains are not connected to sanitary sewer systems and treatment plants? There is no treatment to remove the debris from the water before it reaches nearby lakes, streams, or rivers. The primary purpose of storm drains is to carry rainwater away from developed areas to prevent flooding. When you blow your lawn waste into the street, it can clog storm drains and cause drainage and flooding issues by clogging curb inlets and pipes, which can cause water to back up and flood within the drainage system or the creek.
