- Founded in 1892, the City of Auburn was established before Barrow County was founded.
 - The rail road laid out the street pattern (the map hangs in the council chambers).
- Primarily a farming community the city of Auburn had the first telephone in the area that was used by many around the area to communicate long distance.
- In the late 1800s, Auburn was known as a college town! Auburn was home to the Perry Rainey Institute (founded 1892), an all-women's col-
- The building that sits adjacent to the elementary school was built as the dormitory to the college in 1902. The City of Auburn purchased the building and now it is a great space for citizens and the City to hold events called the Perry Rainey Center.

We are just beginning another year in the history of Auburn with February upon us and the city is busy planning for the all of the activities of the year. IRIS'S INFO CITY CODE CHANGE

During the January 5, 2023 Council Meeting, a new ordinance regarding damage to property, destruction of property, and tampering with infrastructures was passed.



This ordinance will now protect against the damage of property, destruction of property, and tampering with any City property infrastructure. Any person found guilty of violating Chapter 9.16 Section 9.16.010 shall be pun-

ished by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per occurrence.


