
Water Rate Increases Coming in August

We want to inform you about an important development concerning our water rates. Starting this August, there will be an increase in the cost of water services provided by Barrow County, our water supplier. This decision has been made in response to various factors, with the primary consideration being the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

The Consumer Price Index is a metric that measures changes in the average prices of goods and services over time. It serves as an indicator of inflation and allows adjustments to be made to different costs, including water rates. 
