The QR Code below will take you to the City of Auburn website where all new Ordinances will be posted before they are officially added to our City Code on Municode.





Some of the recent ordinances to be updated or added are:

Amongst the new ordinances passed by our City Council is one allowing Golf Carts and other Personal Transportation Vehicles (PTV) to operate on City streets with posted speed limits of 35 mph or less.

UTILITY BILLING FAQ

Ensuring transparency, here are the key steps and dates for our utility billing cycle:

- 1. Bill Distribution:** Bills are generated on the 1st and usually arrive within 7 days.
- 2. Payment Due Date:** Payments are due by the 15th, with a 10% penalty for late payments.
- 3. Disconnection Policy:** Failure to pay or arrange payment by the 25th leads to disconnection the next day. Failure to maintain payment arrangements makes individuals ineligible for future arrangements.
- 4. Bill Inquiry:** Contact us at 770-963-4002 if you haven't received your bill by the 15th.
- 5. Payment Options:** We offer various convenient payment methods:
 - Use the payment drop box at City Hall
 - Make over-the-phone payments
 - Set up automatic drafts
 - Utilize our secure online payment portal
