# MAYOR'S MINUTE



Mayor Rick Roquemore I have heard the comments from many of our citizens about the storm sirens in the City of Auburn. Unfortunately, it is not cost effective to get these sirens up and running as they were hard wired into the former Police Station on 4th Ave.

We are partnering with Barrow County to be able to utilize their emergency warning system. This system places phone calls, emails, and texts to all of those enrolled whenever there is an emergency in Barrow County or the City of Auburn. The City will be able to alert Auburn Citizens specifically of any emergency and you will also receive Barrow county alerts like those for a severe storm.

Utilizing this system will better improve the accuracy and depth of information getting to our citizens. See below on how to get yourself and your loved ones signed up for this service.

# EMERGENCY ALERTS

To sign up for the Emergency Alert System you can go to this address or scan the QR code at the bottom of this page.

You can also sign up by simply texting *BarrowCoGA to 38276*. It is that simple. After enrolling you will receive alerts for myriad of potential emergencies including:

- City of Auburn Emergency Alerts
- Barrow County Road Alerts
- Public Education
- General County News
- Weather Alerts

You can also download an app from the App Store and Google Play Store.

When you sign up you can also manage which notifications you want to receive and how you would like to receive them.

We believe partnering with the Barrow County Alert System will be beneficial to all of our Citizens and help improve the knowledge and safety of Auburn citizens should an emergency occur.






